

HEATER CORE COOLANT HOSES

The heater core coolant hoses on some 1985 Grand Wagoneer vehicles equipped with 4.2L 6-Cyl. engines may contact the heater core housing in the engine compartment.


Reroute the hoses as described in the following procedure.

PROCEDURE

- Inspect the routings of the heater core coolant hoses at the heater core housing (3) of the engine compartment.
- If the heater core coolant hoses are not contacting the heater core housing return vehicle to stock/owner. If either heater core coolant hose is contacting the heater core housing, proceed to Step 3.
- Loosen the heater core coolant hose clamps

 (4) at the heater core. Rotate the hoses counter-clockwise to reposition the hoses away from the edge (3) of the heater core housing.
- 4. Retighten the heater core coolant hose clamps.

5. Tie both of the heater core coolant hoses (1, 2) together using a tie strap (5), P/N 322 3227, or equivalent.



- 6. Start the engine and let it warm to operating temperature.
- 7. Check the heater core coolant hose system for coolant leaks.
