

INOPERATIVE POWER ACCESSORIES


The following power accessories (listed in the sequence of probability) may experience complete or intermittent loss of use: Power Window, Tailgate Window, Power Mirrors, Power Door Locks and/or Power Seats.

This is due to a power window/door lock harness retaining clip located below the front seat belt retractors (B pillar) protruding into the harness.

PROCEDURE

NOTE: Refer to 1986 Electrical Diagrams P/N 8980 010 070. The circuits involved are located between sections 30 and 34. The potential clip interference may occur between connectors 243 and 244 (left side) and connectors 272 and 297 (right side).

- Remove both rear sill plates and both seat belt retractors.
- 2. Remove both left and right harness retaining clips (A).
- 3. Inspect and repair the wiring harness as necessary.
- 4. If the harness has been damaged replace both 30 amp circuit breakers in the fuse panel.

5. Verify proper accessory operation.

- 6. Seal retaining clip screw holes with RTV sealer.
- 7. Apply a 4" × 3" patch of Duct Tape (B) to hold the harness in place.
- 8. Install the seat belt retractors. Torque the seat belt retractor bolt 34-47 N·m (25-35 ft-lbs).

The harness should be routed behind the seat belt retractor plastic stand-offs or the harness may be damaged.

9. Install the sill plates.
